Staff professional development fund (STASH)	\$ 15,000	Funds are used for staff professional development and are administered by a small committee of Lakeside staff members. Both the PGA and School allocate funds to this program every year.
Athletic family support	\$ 6,000	Funding began in 2007 to ensure that no MS parent would be required to pay for additional fees associated with school sport participation.
Educational enrichment fund	\$ 8,000	This fund is specifically designed for enriching the curriculum by supporting opportunities for experiential learning for all students.
PGA scholarship endowment	\$ 2,000	Endowment established by PGA in 1981. Supports the equivalent of two scholarships a year for students at Lakeside.
PGA special needs and opportunity endowment	\$ 2,000	This fund was specifically established to support non- academic needs of students, to ensure they are able to take full advantage of life at Lakeside.
General operating	\$ 100,000	PGA gift to school's general operating budget, amount is consistent with prior years
PGA office remodel	\$ 25,000	Funds to support phase 2 of remodel to make PGA office more accommodating and useful for parents/guardians
Kent Evans Auditorium remodel	\$ 156,000	Funds to update Kent Evans with: new lighting; new seats; a state of the art AV system; a window to let in natural light; new carpet.
LEEP (fully funded by endowment)	\$ 250	Free Lakeside enrichment program supporting public school students entering grades 6 or 9. Serves mainly students of color and those on free or reduced lunch.
