

## 2024 HIGH SCHOOL FOR-CREDIT COURSE APPLICATION INFORMATION

The **High School For-Credit Course Application** is <u>mandatory</u> for all <u>non-Lakeside students</u> and <u>The Downtown School students</u>, if they are taking any of these high school credit-bearing courses:

Accelerated Calculus AB
Algebra 2
Biology
Intro to Photography
Intro to Computer Science
Intermediate Computer Science I
Intermediate Computer Science 2
Physics
Precalculus
Themes in World History
United States History

When registering for a course, the **High School For-Credit Course Application** must also be added to the registration. The application can be found listed above the high school courses. While most registration forms need to be completed at the time of registration, a student can log back into their summer registration account in order to complete the application at their convenience.

## The application consists of:

- 2 short essays (approximately 200 words each). Essay questions: #1: Why do you want to take this course at Lakeside this summer?; #2: What will be your approach to having a successful experience in the course?
- The contact information for 2 teacher references (one Humanities teacher and one Science or Math teacher)
- The student's current 23-24 transcript and 22-23 transcript (to be emailed directly from the student's school to <a href="mailed-summerschool@lakesideschool.org">summerschool@lakesideschool.org</a> or mailed to Lakeside School Summer at Lakeside, 14050 1st Ave NE Seattle, WA 98125)

Enrollment in a course is contingent upon acceptance. Acceptance decisions are made on a rolling basis. It is highly recommended that all application materials are submitted as soon as possible. Materials will not be accepted after June 1. If a student is not accepted into the summer course, a refund for any payment made will be issued.
