

2024 ATTENDANCE POLICY FOR HIGH SCHOOL COURSES.

It is critical for students to attend class and be on time every day in a summer course. Therefore, the only excused absences granted will be for illness or family emergency. All other absences will be unexcused and may result in academic consequences including, but not limited to, grade penalties.

Planned absences, such as missing class for a family trip, an appointment, or a sports tournament, are not permitted.

Three unexcused absences in a six-week course or two unexcused absences in a three-week course will likely result in a failing grade on the student's transcript. Please note that regular and/or significant late arrivals to class will be considered unexcused absences.
