ITEMS THAT WE DO NOT ACCEPT

- anything broken or damaged
- worn or stained upholstered furniture
- most electronics over five years old
- all sofas
- mattresses, box springs
- refrigerators, large appliances
- tires, tire chains
- liquids, hazardous chemicals, paint
- cribs, car seats, booster seats
- baby play centers, baby jumpers, or walkers
- used toys and games, unless collectibles
- all magazines, encyclopedias, text books
- used binders, photo binders
- used bathroom or kitchen fixtures
- custom draperies, window treatments

There is a Goodwill Store and Donation center, very close to Lakeside School. The address is 14500 15th Ave. NE, Shoreline. They can take many of the above items, including old electronics. - Stuff that works!
- Unique, high value, collectable, cool, or exotic items.
- New items still in packaging.
- High quality or name brand audio/video gear.
 - AV receivers.
 - HD, HDMI, Blu-ray, or Bluetooth audio/video items.
 - High quality speakers, large or small.
 - Brand name boom boxes in good condition.
 - Working turntables, amps, or pre-amps.
- Video games:
 - Systems and/or consoles, especially PS3+, Xbox 360+.
 - Handheld gaming units in good working condition.
 - Software, cartridges video games/software - especially rare, collectible, or less than 5 years old.
 - Controllers, cables, cases, etc.
- Working computers/laptops:
 - Mac running OSX 10.6 "Snow Leopard" or later.
 - Windows running Win7 or later.
- Calculators:
 - Especially graphing or programmable (TI-83+, etc.)
 - Any working Lakeside models.
- Smartphones less than 5 years old.
- Flat screen TVs less than 5 years old.
- Software and books less than 5 years old.
- Newer wireless or Bluetooth computer keyboards and mice with "dongle" if required.
- Wireless N standard or newer access points or routers.
- Phones:
 - Collectible in good condition including Princess or classic Bell
 - Cordless 5.8/6.0+ Ghz and less than 5 years old.
- Electronic toys in working condition:
 - R/C anything.
 - Leappad or educational toys.
 - Cool handheld games.
- Working walkie-talkie sets or radio communications gear.
- Electronic musical keyboards or instruments in good working condition.
- Unused printer ink cartridges still in the package.
- Correct power supplies included with donations are most appreciated!

Lakeside Rummage electronics does not need...

- Stuff that doesn't work!
- Filthy, ruined, or broken items.
- Tangled up, low quality and older wires, cords, cables, and/or connectors.
- Non-brand name audio gear more than 5 years old.
- Low quality small speakers, headphones, or ear buds.
- Older orphan remote controls and power adapters.
- VCRs, CD players, low end and/or poor condition cassette tape players, or older DVD players.
- Fax machines more than 5 years old.
- Cell phones or cordless phone sets more than 5 years old.
- Older computer monitors or TVs, especially VGA connect only or less than 19" size - No CRT TVs or monitors please!
- Inkjet printers more than 3 years old. Relatively new, working LaserJet printers are OK.
- Dedicated scanners more than 5 years old.
- Wireless access points or routers more than 5 years old.
- Older wired computer keyboards or mice or wireless with missing "dongles".
- Software more than 10 years old.
- Video console "Rock Band" or "Dance Revolution" type accessories - incomplete sets, non-working, or without included game discs.
- Older or low quality TV antennas.
- Older or non-name brand clock radios.
- Video tapes, cassettes, CDs, floppy disks blank or otherwise. We still need blank DVDs and Blu-ray.
- Dead or leaking batteries.
- Typewriters.
