



SUMMER PROGRAMS

REFUND AND WITHDRAWAL INFORMATION FOR ILC AND ATHLETIC CAMPS

Refunds: All questions about refunds should be directed to the Summer School Programs Office. There will be a cancellation fee for withdrawal from any of the Summer School Programs, except in the case of a COVID-related withdrawal prior to the start of the camp (see COVID-19 refund policy below).

Investigative Learning Camp Withdrawal Fees

- \$50 fee for withdrawals that occur on or before April 1.
- \$100 fee for withdrawals that occur between April 2 and May 1.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the tuition between May 2 and June 1.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals after June 1.

Athletics Camp Withdrawal Fees

- \$25 fee for withdrawals that occur on or before April 1.
- \$50 fee for withdrawals that occur between April 2 and May 1.
- Fifty percent (50%) of the tuition between May 2 and June 1.
- No refunds will be made for withdrawals after June 1.

COVID-19 Refund & Withdrawal Policy:

Should Lakeside Summer School Programs have to cancel any Investigative Learning Camp or Athletic Camps for Summer 2021 due to COVID-19 prior to the start of the program, we will provide a full refund. Should a family need to cancel camp prior to the start of camp for COVID-related reasons (i.e. due to flight restrictions, the student can no longer travel to Seattle), we will provide a full refund. If a student is unable to continue attending the Investigative Learning Camp due to COVID-19 exposure, we will provide a refund of 50% of the tuition for the remaining days that a student is enrolled.

Force Majeure Clause:

Lakeside Summer School Programs will not be responsible or legally liable for any tuition refund or for any loss, costs or damages for any delay or failure of its performance under this agreement, including any changes in programming, cancellation or other alteration, resulting from an act of God or other condition beyond its control (force majeure). Conditions resulting in a force majeure include but are not limited to fire or other natural disaster, war, violence or terrorism, infectious disease epidemic, or other disruptive major event. In the event of a force majeure, Lakeside Summer School Programs will suspend or alter its performance if and until, in its sole discretion, it is able to appropriately resume performance.
